# SITE RULES FOR DRIVERS



# LOWER MELVILLE WOOD LANDFILL SITE

#### **PURPOSE**

The purpose of these site rules is to highlight the potential dangers that exist at this facility, and the measures to be taken to reduce the associated risks. These rules exist to protect you and other site users and, therefore, **must** be complied with.

## Failure to adhere to these rules may result in driver exclusion from site.

10	The site speed limit is 10 M.P.H. Vehicles <b>must</b> not exceed 4 M.P.H. when driving on/off the weighbridge.			
All drivers and visitors must report to site office	Drivers <b>must</b> adhere to guidance and instruction from weighbridge operators and site employees.			
Do not use mobile phones	Mobile telephones <b>must</b> not be used whilst driving.			
NO SMOKING	Smoking (tobacco/vaping) is not permitted at operational areas. This includes whilst you are in the vehicle cab. Smoking areas are provided on site at the welfare facilities.			
Caution Fork-lift trucks operating	Drivers <b>must</b> be aware of other vehicular movement; mobile plant, forklifts and other site users.			
Danger Falling objects	All loads brought to site <b>must</b> be secured in a container or sheeted upon arrival.			
Warning Moving vehicles	When reversing, use mirrors and camera (if fitted) to assist you. If you cannot see what is behind you, stop, alight from the cab and physically check.			
Danger Vehicles unloading	LGV drivers: <b>must</b> communicate with Mobile Plant Operators prior to discharging or being loaded. The driver <b>must</b> be in a position of safety (in cab or at designated safe point) prior to loading/discharging operations.			
Danger Vehicles unloading	Small vans and pick-ups: <b>must</b> adhere to any guidance given to them by Mobile Plant Operators or site employees in the discharge area. Personnel conducting discharge operations <b>must</b> remain in close proximity to their vehicle.

ALL PPE must be worn beyond this point!	When leaving the vehicle cab all drivers <b>must</b> have the appropriate PPE on: <b>safety boots/high visibility top/gloves</b> .		
Strictly no admittance	Never stand or walk beneath a raised tailgate. Clean door seal locking mechanisms from the sid using a brush, or other long handled implement.		
Strictly no admittance	Hook Lift: do not stand or walk across open tailgates where waste can fall on you. Walk around the front of your vehicle or take a wide berth.		
Strictly no admittance	Skips: never walk or stand below a raised skip. Use long reach poles to clear blockages in a skip from the side, in a position of safety.		
Warning Sudden drop	Never climb or access onto a vehicle body unless you can via a designated access route.		
	Ensure that the vehicle container or any other raised part of the vehicle is lowered before leaving the discharge area.		
	Ensure that all container locks, door locks, pins and chains are fully secure before leaving the discharge area.		
Assembly point	Fire assembly points are located at the weighbridge and vehicle car park.		

All injuries, incidents and near misses must be reported to the management prior to leaving site.



Upon leaving the site, all LGVs must only access the A92 by turning left.
Right turns onto the A92 are not permitted.

Once you have read and understood the site rules, you must sign the register at the weighbridge. You will not be permitted access to site unless you have acknowledged these rules.
